I have already testified that I am concerned that current teaching standards are inadequate and that today's students are not getting sufficient education and instruction in 21st century literacy skills.

All this measure requires is that the State Department of Education create an advisory committee to investigate media literacy education currently and make recommendations. (At last week's hearings, SDE reps said they were not opposed to a task force, yet one representative voted to delay action)
