**Remember: confirmation bias can get in the way of our reasoning about whether something is true or false (if we see a post that aligns with our beliefs, we're more likely to believe it, even if there's not much reason to)*

What new information did you learn from the videos that isn't already included in your process for fact-checking claims?

Find Better Coverage: Google keywords or direct quotes (like the headline) from the questionable post, then look for fact checks from known fact-checking sites (Snopes, FactCheck.org, Politifact) or reputable news or other websites.
